Record Crowd! Our third annual dog walk event drew 1,000+ dog enthusiasts and 700+ dogs to the scenic streets and waterfront of Old Town Alexandria's Oronoco Bay Park. The day featured a 2-mile dog walk down Historic Union Street, looping back along the Potomac River for a Sustainability Festival, 65 organizations hosting tables, and other fun activities including a dog obstacle course, dog tattoo artist, a DJ spinning tracks, bubbles floating through the air, kid-friendly fun, a bake sale, free coffee, and much more.

The event also gave back through education, awareness, and support of local nonprofits who hosted plastic-free tables in the ACT for Alexandria Spring2ACTion Nonprofit Village.

Our Way of Giving Back! Every year, we make a special donation to a deserving nonprofit in Alexandria, VA as our thank you to the city that hosts us. This year, we gifted \$5,000 to the Friends of the Mount Vernon Trail. OUR IMPACT!

The ALX Dog Walk strives to acheive three key goals: 1) Build community within the DMV around plastic-free and sustainable living; 2) Raise awareness/educate through the planning and outreach for the annual ALX Dog Walk event (which begins 6 months prior to Walk Day); and, 3) Raise funds for continuous education and outreach long after the dog walk through workshops, social media, etc. As a voluntary nonprofit, we link and leverage our resources with those of other organizations to extend our reach to the fullest extent possible.

Funds raised from the April 20th, 2024 dog walk event accomplished the following:

- Underwrote the annual dog walk event that drew over 1,000+ people/700+ dogs
- Launched our Sustainability Festival
- Launched the pilot, Spring2ACTion Nonprofit Village
- Gifted \$5,000 to the Friends of the Mount Vernon Trail for Trail improvements
- Gifted \$2,000 to The Potomac Conservancy for its plastic/litter pick-up programs
- Gifted \$1,000 to the Plastic Pollution Coalition for its leadership work in the field
- Funded a city-wide education promotion called "Bark Bingo" set for August 2024
 Provided for Goodie Bags and year-long educational materials and resources
- Funded the translation of our children's educational kit to Spanish

OUTSTANDING SURVEY RESULTS!

All registered dog walk participants were surveyed, and here's a brief summary of the results:

- 93% said the quality of the event was "good-excellent" (86% said "very good excellent")
- 85% said they were "very motivated to definitely motivated" to participate in 2025
- 84% said that participation in the dog walk event increased awareness to the plastic crisis
- 78% said they were motivated to change plastic usage habits as a result of the Walk event
- 89% said the quality of the Walk's educational materials were "good to excellent"

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

We are a voluntary non-profit, and 100% net funds support our mission. We're funded through event registration, individual gifts, and business sponsorships.
